Section 1. Chapter 123, Article III, Section 13 of the Code of the Town of New Castle entitled " Full-stop streets " is hereby amended as follows:

§ 123-13 Full-stop streets.

The following public highways are hereby designated as streets upon which a driver of a vehicle approaching a main artery of travel designated in § 123-12 of this Article shall come to a full stop unless otherwise directed by a peace officer:

Section 2. Chapter 123, Article III, Section 15 of the Code of the Town of New Castle entitled “Yield streets” is hereby amended as follows:

§ 123-15 Yield streets.

The following are hereby designated as upon which a driver of a vehicle approaching a main artery of travel designated in § 123-12 of this Article shall operate his vehicle in the manner provided by Vehicle and Traffic Law of the State of New York:

Section 3. Ratification, Readoption and Confirmation

Except as specifically modified by the amendments contained herein, Chapter 123, Sections 13 and 15 of the Code of the Town of New Castle are otherwise to remain in full force and effect and are otherwise ratified, readopted and confirmed.

Section 4. Numbering for Codification

It is the intention of the Town of New Castle and it is hereby enacted that the provisions of this Local Law shall be included in the Code of the Town of New Castle; that the sections and subsections of this Local Law may be re-numbered or re-lettered by the Codifier to accomplish such intention; that the Codifier shall make no substantive changes to this Local Law; that the word “Local Law” shall be changed to “Chapter,” “Section” or other appropriate word as required for codification; and that any such rearranging of the numbering and editing shall not affect the validity of this Local Law or the provisions of the Code affected thereby.

Section 5. Severability.

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section, or part of this chapter or the application thereof to any person, individual, corporation, firm, partnership, entity, or circumstance shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unconstitutional, such order or judgment shall not affect, impair, or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, section, or part of this chapter, or in its application to the person, individual, corporation, firm,

partnership, entity, or circumstance directly involved in the controversy in which such order or judgment shall be rendered.

Section 6. Effective date.

This chapter shall take effect immediately upon filing with the Office of the Secretary of State of the State of New York.
