

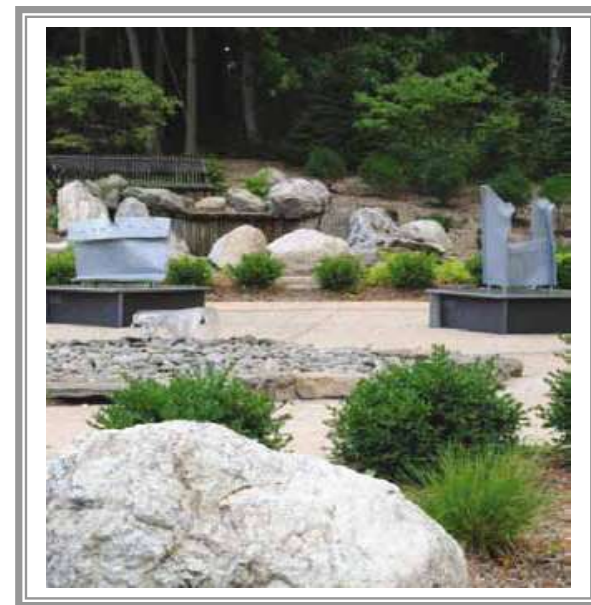
**“National Anthem”
